Due to the City of Silverton restrictions, vehicle traffic (and parking) on the access road or anywhere on the grass portion of the park proper will be limited to authorized vehicles only. Festival vendors will be allowed to load in and load out from the paved roads nearby. Vendors may not tear down earlier than the festival close at 6pm on Sunday. During load in and load out times, we will have volunteers on hand to assist with the process if vendors need help. Under no circumstance will vehicle traffic be allowed inside the park or operating festival during open festival hours.

Limited electricity is anticipated to be available again this year for specific booth locations. It will be on a "first come/first served" basis, determined by the date we receive your booth application. The charge for electricity is \$10.00 per booth space. Booth space will be 10 ft. by 10 ft. Booths that are larger will be charged for 2 spaces. The entrant must provide all booth materials.
